Following a committee resignation Paula agreed to work with Vendor Committee with Chair Quinto Burchi & Erin and Victor Franko.

Janis Flaherty and Victor Franco will be asked to manage setting up in the grooming area to for safety and spacing conditions.

The board will continue to work towards other possible relationships and activities area clubs & special interest dog groups. We will work with specialty clubs to help build our show w/e.

On a **motion by Jean seconded by Neena** the board recommended that TVKC donate a \$5000 scholarship to a UT Vet student from East TN with academic qualifications and a need for funds

Judy brought back information from the delegate meeting regarding AKC CAR's proposal to place Emergency Management Trailers in all USA counties. Each trailer would have all "hardware" needed to assist pet owners having to relocate to an emergency shelter. Once Judy gathers details the club will be encouraged to work towards funding.
