A fun way to demonstrate your dog's good manners. Come help him earn the Canine Good Citizen certificate from the American Kennel Club. The Canine Good Citizen (CGC) Program is designed to reward dogs who have good manners at home and in the community. The Canine Good Citizen Program stresses responsible pet ownership for owners and basic good manners for dogs. All dogs who pass the 10-step CGC test receive a certificate from the American Kennel Club. AKC registered dogs who pass are eligible for the AKC CGC title.
